Important Information

Competition criteria

Closing date for entries is Friday 12th June. Competition entries will be shortlisted by a panel of local community members. The judges will review all art work and finalists will be contacted by Friday 26th June to bring pieces in for a community exhibition based at The Settlement in Maryport.

Final selection of winners will take place at a community exhibition event on Saturday 4th July where visitors will be given the opportunity to vote for their favourite pieces.

As this is a community exhibition please be aware of size and manoeuvrability of artwork. Artists are responsible for bringing artwork to The Settlement by requested date and collection at the end of the Community event.

Entry submissions procedure

1. Entry form with colour photo of artwork to be completed & returned to The Settlement by 4pm on Friday 12th June
2. Entries will be judged week commencing 15th June
3. Shortlisted artworks to be delivered to The Settlement by 5pm on Friday 3rd July
4. Final voting will take place during community event on Saturday 4th July
5. Collection of artwork after 5pm on Saturday 4th July unless otherwise agreed
6. Final winners will be notified by Friday 10th July

Conditions of Entry

- > Re-create is open to all, including artists currently resident in Cumbria.
- > Entrants may only submit one piece of artwork.
- > All artworks must demonstrate the re-use or recycling of waste.
- > Entrants agree that artwork may be photographed, used in promotional material and displayed in any public exhibition held by the organisers.
- > The organisers take reasonable care in dealing with submissions, but cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage which may occur.
- > All artworks remain property of the artist and must be collected at end of exhibition.
